Integration to the Notice of Public Exam for the admission to the doctoral research courses of the 33rd cycle, issued with the Regional Decree n. 1314 of 14.4.2017.

THE CHANCELLOR

Having taken the following into account:

- The proposals for the setting up of Ph.D.s – 33rd cycle – with administrative seat at the University of Genoa, presented by the University Departments and the relevant coordinating bodies for University research regulated by the Statute;
- The note by MIUR (Ministry of Education, University and Research) Prot. No. 11677 of 14.4.2017, concerning the “Guidelines for Accreditation of the doctoral courses”;
- The R.D. n. 1314 of 14.4.2017 with which the notice of public exam for the admission to Doctoral Research courses – 33rd has been issued;
- The resolutions of the Academic Senate during the sessions of 21.02.2017 and of 21.03.2017 and the resolutions of the Board of Governors during the session of 22.02.2017 and of 22.03.2017, with special regard to the course in “Transport, logistics and business intelligence for distribution networks” and to the course in “Paediatric Sciences”;
- That for the course in “Transport, logistics and business intelligence for distribution networks” 33rd cycle, the Academic Senate has approved the publication of the notice of public exam pending the accreditation process, subject to the opinion of the University Evaluation Commission;
- The decision of the Italian Excellency Centre of Integrated Logistics (Centro Italiano di Eccellenza sulla Logistica Integrata – CIELI) of 30.3.2017 with which the modification of the name of the abovementioned course into “Logistics and Transport” and the funding of 2 doctoral grants by CIELI have been approved;
- The simulation relative to ANVUR (the National Agency for the Assessment of University Systems and Research) indicators of the Doctoral School Committee of “Logistics and Transport”, received on 5.5.2017, according to which indicators 1 and 2 relative to the Doctoral School Committee have passed;
- Considering the positive outcome of the ANVUR simulation and having also taken into account the timing for the carrying out of the public exams, the opening of applications for the course in “Logistics and Transport” without the need for a further opinion of the Nucleus can take place;
- That for the doctoral course in “Paediatric Sciences” the Managing Board has approved the conclusion of an Agreement between the University of Genoa and the IRCCS Giannina Gaslini Institute for the implementation and functioning of the course;
- That it was not possible to proceed with the insertion of the course in the abovementioned Notice of Public Exam issued with R.D. n. 1314 of 14.4.2017 because the Agreement was still undergoing the approval of the competent organs of the IRCCS Gaslini;
- That the Agreement was signed on 12.5.2017 and that it is now possible to open applications for the course in “Paediatric Sciences”;
- The Agreement with Department of Neurosciences, rehabilitation, ophthalmology, genetics and mother and child sciences (Dipartimento di Neuroscienze, riabilitazione, oftalmologia, genetica e scienze materno-infantili – DINO GMI), and Sanofi SpA of 16.3.2017, concerning the funding of 1 doctoral grant;
- The decision of DINO GMI of 3.4.2017, concerning the co-funding of 1 doctoral grant.

HEREBY DECREES

Art. 1

1. Appendix A, as per art. 1 of the notice of public exam for the admission to the doctoral research courses of the 33rd cycle, issued by the R.D. n. 1314 of 14.4.2017, is integrated by the document named “**Appendix A – II**”, which is part of this Decree.

Art. 2

1. The remaining provisions as per R.D. n. 1314 of 14.4.2017 are unchanged and the deadline for the presentation of applications is unchanged, set as per art. 3 paragraph 1 of the public notice for the 13 June 2017, 12 noon.
