	Project/scholarship details: The principal aim of the project is to develop technologies to improve the cognitive outcomes of children with neurodevelopmental disorders and specifically develop an innovative cognitive training programme to be delivered over the internet (telerehabilitation). In particular, the project is aimed to respond to the specific clinical need to treat regulation disorders that are frequently and significantly associated to neurodevelopmental disorders. Regulation processes (such as executive function) are those	

skills that allow individuals to accomplish complex activities, such as learning, planning and monitoring behavior in relation to one's goals, regulating attention and managing affects. During the PhD programme, the student will work in collaboration with the software house Anastasis (located in Bologna) for what concerns the development of the software, and with the IRCCS Stella Maris Foundation (located near Pisa) for what concerns the assessment of the efficacy of the cognitive training. The PhD programme will be organized as follows:

- Year 1: development of the general plan of the cognitive training, in collaboration with Anastasis. Pilot study on the training activities. Development of materials associated to the training. These activities will be based on previous studies of the partners (Traverso, L., Viterbori, P., & Usai, M. C. (2015). Improving executive function in childhood: evaluation of a training intervention for 5-year-old children. Frontiers in psychology, 6; Di Lieto, M. C., Inguaggiato, E., Castro, E., Cecchi, F., Cioni, G., Dell'Omo, M., ... & Dario, P. (2017). Educational Robotics intervention on Executive Functions in preschool children: A pilot study. Computers in Human Behavior, 71, 16-23).
- Year 2: efficacy study on the training activities with samples of children with neurodevelopmental disorders.
- Year 3: efficacy of the training activities delivered via telerahilitation with children with different types of disorders.

Project/scholarship details:

The main purpose of the present project is to maximize the efficacy of the Electronic Patient File (EPF) on the performance of the Ligurian health system and citizens' life quality. To achieve this aim, the project supports the technological development of the EPF and favours the implementation of its features through the opportunities coming from the digitalization process that has led to an increase of the horizontalization between Institutions and citizens. A further aim of the project is to promote the dissemination of the digital strategy and e-government.

The expected duration of the project is three years. Its development is tightly related with the different steps of the project within Liguria Digitale S.p.A.

Project/scholarship details:

The construction of inclusive societies represents both a challenge and a need that the present project intends to promote. The research has shown the importance of educational institutions and social-health services in the processes of integration and social inclusion. These contexts represent a resource for the promotion of inclusive dynamics that need to be supported both at a planning level to experiment intervention models and at the level of continuous training of professionals who are involved in the field. Through the close connection with their partners, the project promotes the identification of effective intervention models through the experience and contribution of social planning. Furthermore, it intends to co-construct, through an on-line platform, a transversal and interdisciplinary training model, to support professionals who are faced with the migration problem. Further, it aims to improve the conditions for intervention and promote the well-being of the communities.

The project will be developed with the various partners:

PhD FUNDING	The annual gross amount of the grant, including social security expenses to be paid by the recipient, is \in 16,500.00. The amount of the doctoral grant shall be increased by 50% for an overall period of not more than 18 months, if the graduate student is authorized to by the teaching body to carry out research abroad. Starting from the first year, each graduate student will have, besides the grant, a budget for research activities in Italy and abroad which will not be less than 10% of the grant

SELECTION COMMITTEE	The committees are made up of at least 3 university professors for each course; they may be integrated by not more than 2 experts, who may also be foreign nationals, from public and private research institutions and structures.

TYPE OF ADMISSION TEST	 Comparative assessment of the qualifications/publications. Written test (research project). The interview consists in the discussion of the written test (research project) and the description of the candidate's research area of interest, also on the basis of previous activities stated in his/her scientific-professional curriculum. The tests are focused on confirming the candidates' aptitude for scientific research.

WRITTEN TEST	The research project (10 pages maximum) has to be attached to the online application form, and it must concern one or more research Projects/grants highlighted in the section 'TRAINING PROJECT'. The research project will be evaluated as practical test for the selection, together with the evaluation of the qualifications and the scientific-professional curriculum, in order to identify the candidate's aptitude for scientific research in terms of originality, feasibility, clarity in the definition of objectives, methods and expected results.
INTERVIEW	The interview consists in the discussion of the written test (research project) and the description of the candidate's research area of interest, also on the basis of previous activities stated in his/her scientific-professional curriculum During the interview, the candidate shall also prove his/her proficiency in the following foreign language: English. Non-Italian candidates will also have to prove knowledge of the Italian language.
PERCENTAGE VALUES OF TO EACH TEST	To each candidate can be assigned a maximum of 150 points, divided as follows: - comparative assessment of the qualifications/publications: max score 30/30, pass mark 20/30. - Written test (research project):max score 60/60, pass mark 40/60. - Interview: max score 60/60, pass mark 40/60. The final ranking will be drawn up by adding the scores assigned in comparative assessment, written test and interview. Candidates will be selected in compliance with the principles of equal opportunities.
ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO THE COURSE	In the case of equal grades, the evaluation of candidates' incomes prevails for the assignation of grants, as per D.P.C.M. 9 April 2001
